## FIL BSH

<b>Appearance</b>	white ivory viscous liquid
<b>Constitution</b>	based on quaternary ammonium salt
<b>Active substance</b>	20% app.
<b>pH</b>	4-4.5%
<b>Character</b>	cationic

### Method of use

**FIL BSH** is a chemical that can be used both in wet side and in the finishing.

In the wet side **FIL BSH** behaves as a surface fatliquor giving a very soft handle to the grain.

Furthermore **FIL BSH** gives a grain that is smooth and responds well to mechanical operations.

The harshness of the grain is reduced and therefore the skin reacts well to the brush and acquires again a polished appearance and smooth hand.

**FIL BSH** as fatliquor is also suitable for suede where it gives bright colours and writing effect.

In the finishing **FIL BSH** can be used diluted in water 1:4 or 1:5 in the ground where it confers a natural and very pleasant waxy touch together with a good sealing. In this case it can be combined with **GROUND OIL**, **BIND KV**, **WX BR** and **UR K99**.
